For the first time in many years, Saints Peter and Paul is offering a Service Day on October 22. The day brings together the entire Saints Peter and Paul parish with local organizations across Naperville to serve people in our community. The goal is to strengthen our parish community and serve as the body of Christ to individuals, organizations, and facilities in our greater community.



Volunteers can choose from a variety of service options:

- Pack food at **Feed My Starving Children**
- Grounds maintenance at **Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Cemetery** and **Naperville Park District**
- Indoor (cleaning) and outdoor (gardening) projects on the **Saints Peter and Paul** campus
- Stuffing Christmas stockings for **Operation Support Our Troops**
- Making birthday bags for **Loaves and Fishes** (see reverse)
- Yard clean up through **Naperville Responds for Veterans**
- Collect and sort food donations for **Lisle's West Suburban Food Pantry**
- Sort and organize donations for **Fox Valley Habitat for Humanity's ReStore**
- Share faith and fellowship (and cookies!) with elderly residents at **St. Patrick's Residence, Martin Avenue Apartments** and **Charles Court** by praying a Rosary and sharing conversation
- Play games with residents and purge cabinets/storage areas/closets at **Katharine Manor**

There is a minimum time commitment that varies based on service site assignment; please indicate scheduling challenges on the registration form (see QR code/URL at right). Site captains will reach out to participants with assignment details, which could include a request to bring tools/supplies. Children and teens are welcome with supervising parents; please bring service hour forms if needed. All volunteers are encouraged to bring food donations for West Suburban Food Pantry.
